Name:	Flattened, Blistered, bruised, cut or bleeding nipples		
	Moderate to sever pain when your infant attempts to achieve a latch		
	Infected Nipples

	Engorged or unemptied Breast		
	Premature Self-Weaning		
	Premature reduction of breast milk supply		
Baby	A short shallow ineffective latch		
	Unsustained latch		
Name:	Sliding off nipple		
	Prolonged episodes of non-nutritional breast feeding attempts		
	Unsatisfied nursing episodes		
	Falling asleep before satisfied while attempting to nurse		
	Unable to hold onto a pacifier		
	Poor weight gain, resulting in a diagnosis of failure to thrive infant		
	Chronic Crying Episodes		
	Can only sleep when held upright or in a car carrier		
	Signs of morning congestion- Silent sleeping Stomach Reflux		
	Infant gastroesophageal reflux		
	Clicking and swallowing air when latched (aerophagia)		
	Leaking milk
